

Southern Africa highlights in 9 days, 4*

Day 1

Arrival in Cape Town International Airport at 16:25, transfer to The Portwood Hotel at the Waterfront - vibrant area of the old coal docks, turned into bustling tourist and local attraction. Time to rest, followed by exploring of the area – we watch sun setting into Atlantic Ocean from the Signal Hill overlooking the city. Drive back to the hotel and dinner at one of many restaurants at the Waterfront.

Day 2

Day 3

South Africa is known from its excellent wines, so today we will visit some of the country most prominent wine farms, taste world finest wines and contemplate unique Cape Dutch architecture. But in the morning we will experience entire panorama of Cape Town from the top of the most famous mountain of them all – Table Mountain. Dinner at Moyo – restaurant with an African flavour.

Day 4

After early breakfast we check out and take flight to Johannesburg, on arrival we are transferred to KwaMaritane – bush lodge located in The Pilanesberg National Park – malaria free kingdom of the Big Five. After some rest time we embark on afternoon game drive, with cameras ready we do some serious photo safari.

Visit to Voortrekker Monument, Union Buildings and drive thorough posh suburbs towards Johannesburg. Check in at Da Vinci Hotel in Sandton.

Day 7

After breakfast we depart to the airport and board the plane to Victoria Falls - one of the 7 wonders of the World. On arrival, we are transferred to the A'Zambezi River Lodge, and after rest time, we are transferred to the jetty, where our sunset cruise on the upper Zambezi will take place. With glass of wine or soft drink we are scanning with cameras edge of the forest for antelope or elephant at watering place.

Day 8

Late afternoon we visit Victoria Falls National Park, where deafening sound of the mighty Zambezi plunging into a sheer chasm and the towering spray of the falls, twice as wide and deep as Niagara, is awe-inspiring. A walk through the lush rain forest along the falls brings us almost within touching distance of this Natural Wonder of the World. But before, in the morning, we have free time to do what Adrenalin Victoria Falls have to offer: exhilarating white water rafting – the best in the world, bungi jumping, elephant-back safaris and, yes! walking with the lions.

After morning visit at the local curio market to support local artists and to bring home some interesting batiks or masks, we check out, and transfer to the airport and fly back to Johannesburg. Here we prepare for our final flight at 19:25.
